ALL GRADES

Students at Siena use headsets as a part of daily learning, both at home and in the school building. The earphones allow them to use text-to-speech feedback, read along with an audiobook on Learning Ally, and practice core literacy skills through various reading applications. It is also important that the headset **have a microphone**, which allows them to easily dictate writing to the computer, and record rich, multisensory voiceovers and videos for class projects, even while working in a room with others.

If the recommended models, linked below, are not available or affordable when you go to purchase them, please see the criteria for headsets below to select one.

HEADSET CRITERIA

- Headsets should include an integrated microphone, either on a stem or in line with the headset's cable
- Headsets should plug into the computer **via USB** for easiest compatibility and best audio quality
- Headsets should be the **over-ear variety, rather than in-ear**. Sets that have **ear cushions** which completely surround the ear are preferable.
- We generally recommend **against wireless headsets**. They will work, but tend to have a higher error rate and require more frequent troubleshooting than wired USB models.
- Headset cases are strongly recommended.

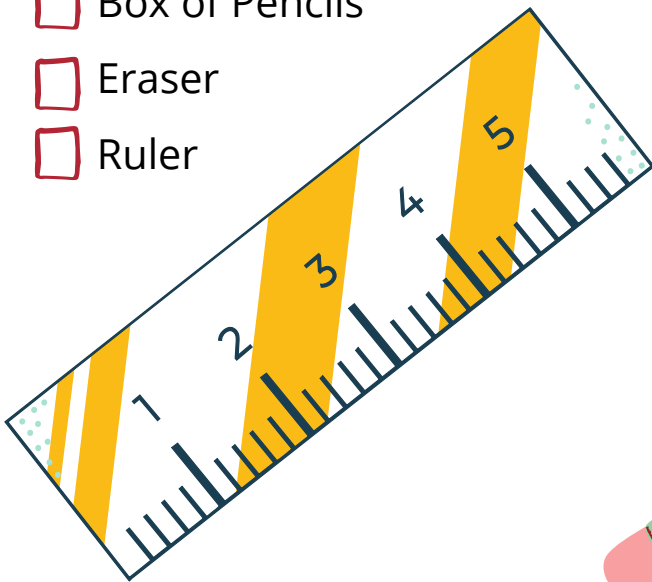
