








Get Creative with Cameras

- Document camera and instrument to capture handwriting
- Use a phone to record tutorial videos
 Second device with a different camera angle
- Mirror smartphones and tablets to your computer









G Suite (or Office 365)

- Easy collaborative documents, spreadsheets, and slide decks
- Assistive add-ons like Read&Write
- Templates for worksheets and graphic organizers available online
- Easy to make copies for students (Google Classroom)

 <u>Color-coding, insert images and drawings</u>, easily link to other resources













Graphic Organizers and Infographics

- Google Docs, Slides, and Sheets

- Google Forms
 Canva for charts, graphs, and infographics
 Powtoon and Storyboard That for organizing narratives


















TIPS FOR ENGAGEMENT

Students need to be seen and heard so they don't feel invisible and stay engaged and connected.



Resources

Teach/practice inflection and phrasing

- → Create new norms
- → Survey with Google Forms
- → Multisensory Learning
- → Go Noodle
- **→** SMART Notebook
- → Move offline e.g. scavenger hunt







TIPS FOR ENGAGEMENT

Fluency Practice

Teach/practice inflection and phrasing

- → Monologues
- → Poetry
- → Speeches
- → Reader's Theater
- → Tongue Twisters

Book Club

Remember to pin the student speaking

- → Talk show with book characters
- → Poems using vocabulary
- → Postcards from a character
- → Dating App Profiles
- → Unscramble events
- → Letter to a character

Creative Assignments

Variety maintains student interest, e.g. accumulative works

- → Sharing work
- → Pairs in breakout rooms
- → 1:1 Conferencing
- → Performance e.g. invite parents to a sharing
